Nomad announces new projects

Cloudbreak Mine Accommodation Village

Nomad Building Solutions Limited (ASX: NOD) announced today that it has been awarded a substantial contract by Fortescue Metals Group Limited (ASX: FMG) for its Cloudbreak Mine Accommodation Village in the Pilbara region, Western Australia.

The project is a 504 person accommodation village with facilities plus an additional installation package of 200 rental accommodation rooms. The value of the contract is approximately \$32.5 million.

Preliminary construction works for the project have commenced and Nomad is expected to mobilise to site in early November 2006. Project completion is expected to occur in May 2007.

McGrath Homes

Nomad announced today that McGrath Homes has been awarded a substantial project for the supply and delivery of 42 permanent housing dwellings in Newman, Western Australia.

The value of the contract is approximately \$16.2 million. Work on the project is expected to commence in December 2006 with completion expected in November 2007.

Nomad is a leading provider of modular building solutions utilised by companies operating in the resources (mining and oil & gas), infrastructure, building construction, tourism and leisure sectors.

As outlined in its prospectus dated 25 September 2006, Nomad has entered into an agreement to acquire McGrath Homes with an effective date of 1 December 2006.
